**ADEMCO** has partnered with **OzVision** to integrate a new remote video transmission system, the **OzLine-4**, with the AlarmNet central station communication services. The system will deliver high-quality remote video images over standard telephone lines to ADEMCO Group's AlarmNet server system, which in turn transmits the video images to a central station. The AlarmNet services will be deployed and fully integrated into central station automation systems in the near future. The OzVision agreement is part of an overall ADEMCO plan to add dialer and Internet-based solutions to the AlarmNet suite of services.

**DICE Corporation** has formed a partnership with **OzVision Remote Video Solutions** to integrate remote video and GPS technology with central station automation software. According to DICE, it is the first time that remote video, GPS, and central station automation are being fully automated for commercial use anywhere in the world.
